



STRIPPY SQUARE

You have four 4.5" squares and a bag of scraps



1. Sew your strips together to make a piece of fabric about 11" wide.

Keep one edge straight.

You will need enough stripped pieces to cut four 4.5" x 10.5" pieces



2. Take one strip (4.5 x 10.5) and fold in half lengthwise.

Place the diagonal line of your ruler along the folded edge, with the point at the end.

Cut the corner triangle off.

Repeat at the other end and for all the strips



*3. Take the 4.5" back ground squares.
Cut each one in half through the diagonal.*

4. Stitch a triangle to each side of your stripped pieces



4b. Trim the block to 7 inches

*5. Join your pieces to make the
Strippy Square.*

*The centre triangles will all be
different.*
